1 Secretary's Report

6 Winter Field Day (Jan 25 to 26, 2025)

We earned 1077 total points for WFD and logged 147 contacts. Learned lessons around the power consumption and the number of batteries. Need to simplify the system and figure out a better way to keep track of the batteries and what they are powering. Some piece of equipment is consuming more power than other equipment.
